If selected, your term would extend to Dec. 2020 with the option of reapplying, if you are not an incoming college senior. Students must be able to attend all four scheduled meetings that will take place on a monthly basis, to remain in good standing with the Council.

Requirements:

- Must reside within Florida's 26th Congressional District
- Completed Application Form
- Completed and signed Consent Form
- Updated Resume/CV
- Official high school/college transcript
- One-page essay explaining why you wish to be a Member of the Council
- Two Letters of Recommendation

- This will be a student-driven council.
- There will be 4 scheduled meetings with staff per cycle. Students must attend all 4 to remain in good standing with the Council.
- If selected, students will be appointed to a full term until Dec 2020.
- No more than one to two students per school will be selected.
- Freshmen in High School should submit 8th grade transcripts as well as a current progress report.
